ACADEMIC/SPORTING AWARDS POLICY

Introduction

This policy serves to provide guidelines concerning the description and criteria to be followed and adhered to when selecting learners for academic and sporting awards. The purpose of the policy is to facilitate good organisation and accountable making of awards.

Academic

1. Book Prizes

1.1 Recipients

Each learner in Grades 0 – 2 receives a book prize.

2. Reading Certificates

2.1 Recipients

Certificates are issued to learners in Grade 2 – 7. Each grade will have 3 recipients using the following criteria;

- Excellent progress in reading comprehension and word recognition – 3year improvement required to qualify.
- Exceptionally good in reading comprehension – 2year improvement required to qualify.
- Good progress in word recognition and reading comprehension – 1year improvement required to qualify.

2.2 Reading Ages above chronological ages

Learners from Grade 2 – 7 whose reading ages are 3 years above their chronological ages receive this award.

3. Good Manners and Behaviour

3.1. Recipients

Learners from Grade 0 – 7 are eligible to receive this award at the teacher’s discretion. The award is aimed at pupils who are always worthy in terms of behaviour, attitude, dress, participation in class and activities.

4. Academic Subject Certificates

4.1 Recipients

Learners from Grade 3 – 7 receive these certificates for top achievement in their class for academic subjects.

5. Academic Attainment Certificates

- 5.1** Learners from Grade 3 – 7 receive academic achievements for Positions 1st, 2nd and 3rd in their class. This is determined by the highest average mark attained in all subjects measured over all three terms.
- 5.2** An award for Academic Endeavour may be given to the learner who has applied themselves in all areas of class work. This is not necessarily the top achiever but the pupil who exhibits consistent commitment to their academic work.
- 6. Club Awards**
- 6.1** Junior Awards criteria is based on Enthusiasm Commitment, consistent participation.
- 6.2** Senior Awards criteria is based on Enthusiasm Commitment, consistent participation
- 7. Sport Awards**
- 7.1** For each sport, there are four (4) categories for awards;
- Most Outstanding Player
 - Most Promising Player
 - Most Improved Player
 - Most Spirited Player
- 8. Trophy/Major Awards**
- 8.1 BOARD OF DIRECTORS TROPHY**
Interhouse Academics – House scoring most points based on accumulation of Term 1, 2, 3 points.
- 8.2 LANDLESS SHIELD**
Interhouse Sport – Overall winning house – All sport.
Determined on points. Win = 2 Draw = 1 Loss = 0
- 8.3 QUENET TROPY**
Senior Interhouse Cricket – winning house team.
Determined on points. Win = 2 Draw = 1 Loss = 0
- 8.4 ARNOLD CUP**
Interhouse Hockey – winning house all teams.
Determined on points. Win = 2 Draw = 1 Loss = 0
- 8.5 COWLEY TROPHY**
Best Batsman – in the Senior Boys XI.
- 8.6 LION KOP RANCH TROPHY**
Best ALL Round Cricket – Senior Boys XI
- 8.7 JOGEE TROPHY**
Most Promising Colt Cricketer

- 8.8 MOST OUTSTANDING ARTIST**
Chosen from Grade 4 – 7.
- 8.9 MARX TROPHY**
The most promising Colts Rugby Player
- 8.10 MAC DONALD TROPHY**
Most spirited Senior Netball Player
- 8.11 MULDER'S FAMILY TROPHY**
The most outstanding Senior Rugby Player
- 8.12 ILLMAN TROPHY**
Most outstanding Hockey Player from Senior, Boys/ Girls
- 8.13 BECKY PIETERSE CUP**
Most Promising Senior Girl Tennis Player
- 8.14 THE EKSTEEN SWIMMING TROPHY**
Outstanding performance, style and technique – All Senior swimmers are eligible
- 8.15 MUNG'OMBA TROPHY**
Best Junior Sports Student
Multiple codes. Perform in codes. Scoring system.
- 8.16 COXE FAMILY" TROPHY**
Contributing the most to the Grade 7 "Outreach" Program
- 8.17 SHENTON FELLOWSHIP AWARD**
A good leader who looks after other children, and shows care and compassion for them. They are looked up to and respected by others.
- 8.18 ZAMBIAN STUDIES AWARD**
Zambian Studies Top Achiever – given to the child in any grade, who displays superior and excellent achievement in all Zambian Studies work throughout the year.
- 8.19 DEPARTMENT AWARD**
Well groomed and well turned out Grade 7. Always looks neat and tidy and dresses well.

- 8.20 LEGG TROPHY – Drama**
Best senior actor or actress chosen from end of year play and the annual major school production.
- 8.21 BECKETT AWARD**
Endeavour and progress in reading. By any Grade 2 – 7 learner.
- 8.22 ROOKSANA ARMSTRONG MEMORIAL TROPHY**
Most Improved Junior Sportsman. Boy/ Girl all/ any code eligible.
Multiple codes participation.
- 8.23 RAVI SHANKAR TROPHY – Science and (Technology)**
The recipient is Senior pupil who excels at Science and Computer.
(Excellence in Science and excellence in computer skills/ knowledge.)
- 8.24 THE BURKE FAMILY TROPHY – Best Public Speaker in Grade 7.**
- 8.25 TOM BURKE CUP – for English**
Award to the best English student in Grade 7
- 8.26 CHARLES SKUY CUP**
Best Mathematics performance by a Grade 7 learner.
- 8.27 THE CUSTOS TROPHY - Conservation and Environmental Award**
Awarded to a pupil in Gr4 – 7 who has a natural love for outdoors and bush life. Is also extremely knowledgeable on these matters.
- 8.28 DARRYN JACKMAN MEMORIAL TROPHY**
Awarded to Grade 4 – 7 pupil for Academic Perseverance
The key word here is “perseverance”. Someone who always tries hard with their academic tasks, even if they find the work difficult.
- 8.29 “DIESEL” AWARD**
Awarded to the most enthusiastic Grade 7 pupil
- 8.30 STEPHANIE SMITH MEMORIAL MUSIC TROPHY**
Awarded to the most talented pupil in any musical discipline.
- 8.31 SPORTS PERSON OF THE YEAR - Senior**
All round performance in all sports. Not only do they have natural sporting ability but also display good sporting conduct. Participation and achievement in multiple codes a prerequisite for qualification.
- 8.32 BOARD OF DIRECTORS TROPHY**
Awarded to the best Academic performance based on all 3 Term’s marks accumulated in the academic year. Grade 7 pupils are eligible.
